Becoming an Editor or Contributor: SHARIASource Portal or Islamic Law Blog

Editors who contribute to the [SHARIASource Portal](#) are selected on the basis of their expertise. Each has advanced degrees in Islamic law or other topics relevant to Islamic legal studies and excellent standing in their fields. Editors gather primary sources and provide basic commentary about them on the portal. Contributors, as opposed to editors, are typically invited guests who contribute posts and are vetted through a process of peer review, and/or guided by an editor. Acceptance and publication of solicited and unsolicited contributions is at the sole discretion of SHARIASource. Proposals can be submitted [here](#).

Editors who contribute to the [Islamic Law Blog](#) are typically invited, on the basis of their expertise. Each has advanced degrees in Islamic law or other topics relevant to Islamic legal studies and excellent standing in their fields. Contributors to the blog are invited and contribute posts to a thematic roundtable organized by our blog. Student Editors contribute posts in the Islamic Law course or participation in the SHARIASource Lab, engaged in deep into a subject of their choice based on new or historical cases, fatwās, or other sources of law. Staff / Research Editors contribute commentaries on recent publications, Islamic law primary sources, current events, roundtables, and more.
